

St. Luke's Hospital Education to Employment *Imaging Technologist* Scholarship Program

The scholarship program at St. Luke's Hospital (SLH) in Chesterfield, MO, St. Luke's Des Peres Hospital (SLDP) in Des Peres, MO, or Outpatient settings is designed to provide financial support for Imaging Technology Students enrolled in an accredited imaging technology program. Our goal is to raise awareness, increase the number of imaging technologists entering the profession and provide opportunities for employment at our St. Luke's Hospitals or Outpatient Settings. Two \$5,000 scholarships will be awarded.

Admission Criteria:

- Enrolled and accepted into a full-time JRCERT accredited associate or baccalaureate degree imaging technology program and graduating within 12 months.
- Résumé.
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- A transcript verifying GPA and current enrollment.
- Letter of recommendation from the program director.
- A typed 300-word essay on why they have chosen imaging technology as their profession.

Required Commitments:

- Student must be in their second year of the Imaging Technology Program.
- Must work as an Imaging Student on a Per diem basis, variable work schedule.
- Required to work 2 years post-graduation as full-time Registered Radiologic Technologist or Sonographer (36 hours per week).



Imaging Technologist Scholarship Program

Application Process (applicant is responsible for the following):

- Scholarship application.
- Members of the SLH, SLDP, Outpatient Imaging leadership team will serve on the review and selection committee.

▶ Timeline:

- Open application period: July 30 – August 12, 2022
- Review and selection process: August 15, 2022
- Recipients notified by: August 19, 2022
- Disbursement issued: Within 10 days of meeting all criteria. Taxes apply.

Awarded scholarship will be repaid within 10 days by the applicant in the event:

- A recipient fails to successfully complete the academic year.
- A recipient receives a grade under 2.0 (C or below), recipient is required to submit grades each semester.
- A recipient does not obtain the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT(R) or Sonography certification (ARDMS) following graduation.
- A recipient does not complete 2 years of employment as an ARRT(R) or ARDMS within 90 days after finishing the academic program.
